The 2010 recipient was Alejandro “Alex” Castor from Argyle High School. Alex is currently attending The University of Houston.

The committee will accept one (1) application from each school. The recipient of the scholarship will be a student that has demonstrated excellence in the classroom, performance on the football field, leadership on the team, in the school and in his community. The needs of the student will also be considered. A statement from the student regarding the impact of football on his life will also be reviewed by the committee. There will be no restriction on the area of study the student selects. Equal consideration will be given to students planning to attend a 4-year University, Jr. College or Vocational training school.

Applications must be emailed or postmarked by April 22nd. By submitting an application, the student authorizes review of the application by all members of the scholarship committee. Announcement of the scholarship recipient will be made on May 2nd. The recipient, accompanied by his Coach and family, will be expected to attend a General Membership meeting of the Fort Worth Football Officials Association on or about July 18^h for recognition and presentation of the Student to the Chapter Membership.

The Fort Worth Football Officials Association has made a commitment to return as much as we can to the students that we have the privilege to serve. We appreciate your confidence in the Fort Worth Football Officials Association and look forward to serving you in the seasons to come.
